As a result of Senate Bill 855 (Chapter 29, Statutes of 2014), the 2015 CalWORKs Annual Summary was developed to provide a comprehensive overview of the CalWORKs program. The document is organized into nine chapters covering topics such as: CalWORKs caseload information, benefit and earnings levels, welfare-to-work participation, recent program changes, information on poverty levels and links to pertinent data sources.
