REFERENCE: WELFARE AND INSTITUTIONS CODE (WIC) SECTIONS 11460(b); PUBLIC LAW (PL) 110-351; <u>ACL NO. 11-51</u>

The purpose of this ACL is to provide instruction and guidance to county child welfare and probation departments regarding the use of the SPC for education travel: S-1 Education Travel Reimbursement.

In 2010 PL 110-351 amended Title IV-E of the Social Security Act to allow for reimbursement to the foster care providers for the cost of reasonable travel to and from school for a child to remain in the school in which they are enrolled at the time of placement as an allowable Foster Care maintenance cost.

In ACL NO. 11-51, counties were advised to use the SPC S-1 Education Travel Reimbursement until the system change that provides Child Welfare Services/Case Management System (CWS/CMS) functionality for documenting Educational Travel Reimbursements had been put in place. This SPC allowed counties to identify, track and claim children/youth receiving the education travel reimbursement. The system All County Letter No. 16-04 Page Two

changes to CWS/CMS have been completed and SPC S-1 Education Travel Reimbursement should no longer be used. The California Department of Social Services has discovered some counties are still using the SPC which ended in 2012. Effective the date of this letter, the state will end the county's access to the SPC S-1 Education Travel Reimbursement.
