SUBJECT: DISASTER GUIDANCE ATTACHMENT – DISASTER SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM INCOME ELIGIBILITY STANDARDS AND ALLOTMENTS EFFECTIVE **OCTOBER 1, 2013**

This letter is to inform counties that the United States Department of Agriculture, Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) has issued the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2014 Disaster Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (D-SNAP) Income Eligibility Standards and Allotments for the following period October 1, 2013 through October 31, 2013. The allotment amounts remain unchanged for FFY 2014.

However, effective October 1, 2013, the D-SNAP net monthly income eligibility levels are increasing for all household sizes. The maximum shelter deduction will increase from \$469 to \$478, and will apply to *all* households, including those with elderly or disabled members. The standard deduction amount for household sizes one, two, and three will increase from \$149 to \$152 a month. The computation below shows how FNS computes the Disaster Gross Income limits for a one person household:

Maximum Monthly Net Income Limit for household size of one (100% of FPL)	+ \$958
Maximum Standard Income Deduction	+ \$152
Maximum Shelter Expense Deduction	+ \$478
Disaster Gross Income Limit	= \$1588
