ADJUSTMENT - EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2016

REFERENCE: UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, FOOD AND NUTRITION SERVICE - ADMINISTRATIVE NOTICE 16-38

The purpose of this letter is to inform counties that the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) has issued the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2017 adjustment for inflation to the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) maximum allowable resources. Under the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008, resource limit adjustments are effective October 1, 2016.

The resource limit for households will remain unchanged at \$2,250. The resource limit for households if at least one person is age 60 or older, or is disabled, will remain unchanged at \$3,250.
