SUBJECT: CORRECTION TO ALL COUNTY INFORMATION NOTICE (ACIN) NO.

I-79-03, DATED NOVEMBER 13, 2003, FOOD STAMP QUESTIONS

AND ANSWERS (Q&As)

The purpose of this errata is to transmit clarification to ACIN I-79-03, regarding the question (located on page 10) about "Treatment Of Income – Basic Allowance For Housing In The Military". The correct response is as follows:

Question: Some military housing is now being contracted out to property management firms. Is the Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH) excluded as a vendor payment?

Answer: No. Per CFR 237.9 (vii) "moneys legally obligated and otherwise payable to the household which are diverted by the provider of the payment to a third party for a household expense shall be counted as earned income and not excluded". The Food and Nutrition Service considers the BAH legally obligated and otherwise payable to the household.

Please replace ACIN I-79-03 with this transmittal, ACIN I-79-03E.
