SUBJECT: REVISED DISASTER FOOD STAMP PROGRAM (DFSP) GUIDE AND

REVISED DFSP INCOME STANDARDS AND ALLOTMENTS EFFECTIVE

OCTOBER 1, 2008

This letter is to inform counties that the United States Department of Agriculture, Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) has revised the Disaster Guide as of April 2008 and has also issued a newly-revised Income Eligibility Standards and Allotments Guide effective October 1, 2008. The revised Disaster Guide provides a significant amount of new and revised information regarding disaster preparation and response. The guide can be accessed at:

This letter transmits the revised Income Eligibility Standards and Allotments Guide. As of October 1, 2008, the shelter expense deduction will increase from \$431 to \$446 for new applications and re-certifications occurring on or after the above date. As a result of the increase in the shelter expense deduction, the disaster gross income limit, which includes income and liquid resources, will also increase. County staff can update their Disaster Food Stamp Handbooks by obtaining the current income and eligibility standards at:
