

SUBJECT: BALDERAS VS. WOODS

REFERENCE:

In order to comply with the Preliminary Injunction in Balderas vs. Woods, it is necessary for the Department to obtain data upon which to base an estimate of suspension rather than discontinuance when the recipient fails to return a complete CA 7.

To obtain the data a survey will be conducted during April and May. Counties will be required to forward survey data to us early in June. Therefore, we are informing you of the Department's intentions for the survey so that you can begin planning for data collection.

Seventeen counties, listed at the end of this letter, were selected to participate. These counties provide a representative sample of the State for purposes of this survey.

As a first step in the survey, we would like to have the name, title, office address, and telephone number of the contact person responsible for coordinating this survey in each of the seventeen counties selected.
