ALL-COUNTY INFORMATION NOTICE I-93-81

TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: DAVIS v. WOODS

REFERENCE:

On July 28, 1981, we informed you by telegram that Los Angeles Superior Court Judge Robert Weil had issued a Temporary Restraining Order in the case of Davis v. Woods.

The order restrains the Department of Social Services and all county welfare departments from:

"(1) Discontinuing, terminating or reducing the AFDC benefits of plaintiffs and all other AFDC recipients who are otherwise eligible and who are or who have in their families a dependent child 18-20 years old who is regularly attending school, college, university or technical or vocational training;

"(2) Failing to grant assistance to all AFDC applicants who are otherwise eligible and who are or have in their families a dependent child 18-20 years old who is regularly attending school, college, university or technical or vocational training."

A copy of the Temporary Restraining Order is attached for your information.

The Department is requesting from the Department of Finance the funds necessary to implement the provisions of the order.

A hearing on plaintiffs' request for a preliminary injunction has been set for August 12, 1981. Also set for the same time is a hearing on the issue of whether the Directors of Social Services and Finance should be held in contempt of court for allegedly failing to comply with the provisions of the Temporary Restraining Order.
