SUBJECT: VOLUNTARY QUIT SANCTION CHANGE FROM DATE OF APPLICATION TO DATE OF DUIT

The purpose of this letter is to advise you that this department has been informed by Federal Food Stamp Program Policy Memo 86-2 of an error in the Federal Food Stamp Program amendments to the regulations issued October 3, 1984.

When the final rule was published, the second sentence of Paragraph (v) of Section 273.7(n)(1) was inadvertently changed to, "starting from the date of quit". The Federal Food Stamp Program is in the process of issuing a new amendment to their regulations correcting this error.

Based on this forthcoming Federal amendment, the Department is in the process of amending State policy and regulations to have the 90 day sanction for persons who quit their job without good cause commence from the date of the quit, rather than the date of application.
