IMPLEMENTATION EVALUATION REPORT (PIER) FOR THE

STATEWIDE AUTOMATED WELFARE SYSTEM (SAWS)

Reference: Manual of Policies and Procedures (MPP),

Section 28-130

The purpose of this notice is to provide information concerning the requirement for the counties to develop and submit a PIER on their SAWS Central Data Base (CDB) project. The Department is required to submit a statewide PIER to the state Office of Information Technology once the CDB system has been fully implemented and the system has been operational for a reasonable period of time. Individual county CDB PIERs will serve as the basis for the development of a statewide CDB PIER.

We are currently developing a CDB PIER format and instructions for all counties to use in preparing their individual PIERs. You should not prepare your individual PIERs until the format and instructions are issued. We expect the format and instructions to be issued within 6 to 8 weeks.

Although a pilot evaluation has been completed for the SAWS CDB pilot counties, an individual county PIER will be required from all counties.
