ALL-COUNTY INFORMATION NOTICE NO. 1-49-89

TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: THE CONFIDENTIALITY OF AIDS MEDICAL INFORMATION IN IN-HOME SUPPORTIVE SERVICES

This All-County Information Notice (ACIN) reviews current statutes for the release of medical information regarding individuals with Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS). While these statutes do not expressly address the disclosure of AIDS medical information on In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) recipients to their service providers, they do provide a context in which to develop policy and procedures.

Current law, as discussed herein, imposes limitations on the disclosure of AIDS medical information and establishes the confidentiality of agency records. County Welfare Departments (CWDs) should consider these restrictions when making decisions regarding the release of such information to an IHSS provider.

The release of AIDS medical information in the provision of IHSS is subject to the following statutes:

- 1. Health and Safety (H&S) Code Section 199.21 prohibits negligent or willful disclosure of results of blood tests to detect the AIDS virus (human immunodeficiency virus or "HIV") to any third party in a manner which identifies the test subject without written authorization, as defined, or except as otherwise provided by law. See also H&S Code Section 199.24.
- 2. H&S Code Section 199.20 protects the privacy of subjects of HIV testing by providing that no person shall be compelled in any judicial, administrative, or legislative proceeding to identify such individuals unless a statutory exception applies.

- 3. H&S Code Section 199.42 (a) provides that public health records relating to AIDS and containing personally identifying information are confidential and shall not be disclosed, except as otherwise provided by law for public health purposes or pursuant to a written authorization by the person who is the subject of the record. However, the disclosure shall include only information necessary for the purpose of the disclosure and only upon agreement that it is kept confidential.
- 4. H&S Code Section 199.42 (b) specifies that "state or local public health agencies may disclose personally identifying information in public health records... to other local, state, or federal public health agencies or to corroborating medical researchers, when the confidential information is necessary to carry out the duties of the agency or researcher in the investigation, control, or surveillance of disease, as determined by the state or local public health agency."

  However, the disclosure shall include only information necessary for the purpose of the disclosure and only upon agreement that it is kept confidential.
- 5. Welfare and Institutions Code Section 10850 (a), in relevant part, provides that, unless otherwise specified, "all applications and records concerning any individual made or kept by any public officer or agency in connection with the administration of... public social services for which grants-in-aid are received by this state from the United States government shall be confidential, and shall not be open to examination for any purpose not directly connected with the administration of such program."

In addition, the Governor recently signed legislation concerning the disclosure of HIV test results. Assembly Bill (AB) 3255, Chapter 1582, Statutes of 1988, permits disclosure of test results without the test subject's written authorization to the subject of the test, the subject's legal representative, the subject's health care provider, as defined by Civil Code Section 56.05(d), and agents and employees of that health care provider who render direct patient care and treatment. (See H&S Code Section 199.24.) The legislation provides that inclusion of HIV test results in medical records is not a disclosure subject to criminal and civil sanctions. (See H&S Code Section 199.21(1).) It also replaces the requirements of written consent for an HIV test with informed consent in the case of a physician or surgeon treating a patient. (See H&S Code Section 199.22(a).)

SDSS is also monitoring the implementation of AB 3673, Chapter 1475, Statutes of 1988, which authorizes the State Department of Health Services to study various methods that should be used to protect persons employed in occupations that involve possible exposure and transmission of the AIDS virus. SDSS will advise Counties of the impact of AB 3673 on IHSS when the study is completed.

Attached to this ACIN is a list of Community Education and Prevention Projects throughout the State. These Centers provide general information training on AIDS, and some provide training at minimal cost to workers on infection control procedures when dealing with AIDS and other communicable diseases.

This issue focuses on the competing interests of a recipient's right to confidentiality and the provider's right to be informed of possible exposure to AIDS and other communicable diseases. SDSS, in coordination with the Adult Services Committee of the California Welfare Directors Association (CWDA) and the Office of AIDS, will continue reviewing the AIDS confidentiality issue and consider initiating specific legislation that addresses the needs of IHSS providers and recipients. CWDs will be advised when a specific policy on the release of medical information to IHSS providers is adopted. Until then, CWDs should develop policies and procedures based upon the needs of their jurisdiction and the legal advice of their County Counsels.
