REFERENCE: ALL COUNTY LETTER (ACL) NO. 15-06

The purpose of this errata is to instruct County Welfare Departments to disregard the statement found in ACL 15-06 on the bottom of page two, which reads, "Effective July 1, 2014, for CalFresh households with conferred modified categorically eligible status, the IRT is 200 percent of the Federal Poverty Level (refer to <u>ACL No. 14-56</u>). The current CalFresh IRT levels are listed in ACIN No. I-53-14."

The CalFresh Policy Bureau will issue a separate ACL with guidance regarding the CalFresh IRT for families with conferred modified categorically eligible status. In addition, an errata to ACL No. 14-56 will be released concurrently. For questions regarding the IRT for CalFresh households, please contact the CalFresh Policy Bureau at (916) 654-1896.

There is also a typo on the attachment in the Region 1 chart number 2 under the non-exempt column for an AU of eight. The correct IRT amount is \$2,792. A corrected version of the chart is attached.
