**SERIOUS CRIMES** 

The purpose of this errata is to transmit a correction to the above-referenced ACL regarding the social security requirement exception for those noncitizen individuals applying for CalWORKs and/or food stamp benefits who claim the status of a victim of human trafficking or other serious crimes pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code Section 18945.

The social security requirement exception should also include non-citizen victims of domestic violence. Therefore, victims of human trafficking, domestic violence, or other serious crimes do not have to provide or apply for a social security number as a condition of eligibility for statefunded CalWORKs or food stamp benefits.
