



## What Makes Data Important?

1. Illustrating our growth and impact as a program

 Measuring effectiveness of program changes
Ensuring we maximize use of valuable resources

#### What is a "Data Story"?

Data isn't all spreadsheets and numbers!



#### How are data stories valuable to us?

- Further understand the impact that you, program operators, have on our communities
- Gain deeper insight into how our program works
- Help us to learn and grow through reflection
- Make it easier for us to see the "bigger picture"

#### Data stories can...

- Help us create a narrative that evokes emotions and drives action
- Tell us a story about where we are and where we want to go
- Illustrate complex ideas in a way that is easy to understand

### The CACFP Data Story

## The CACFP Data Story (1)

In a small Sacramento town, lives a family of five.

Mary, Gary, Harry, Sherry, and Larry use the CACFP to help them thrive!



## The CACFP Data Story (2)

## The CACFP Data Story (6)


This isn't the only family, that benefits from CACFP.

As of October, 2023. Each Icon represents roughly 300 - 500 participants.




- This is an illustrated chart of people icons representing the amount of Sacramento participants in CACFP as of October 2023.

## The CACFP Data Story (9)


Sacramento County isn't the only one.

## The CACFP Data Story (10)




Working hard day and night to make sure people eat,


With data stories, there is so much to know.





#### Other Useful Insights from Data: Administrative Reviews


In four years, and 1,256 reviews....

...a majority of administrative reviews resulted in no fiscal actions required



### A total of 1,256 Administrative Reviews were analyzed from 2018-2021

#### AR Findings Most Common to Least Common



Eligibility was the most common, with a total of 551 findings

#### Of the 551 Eligibility findings...


