SUBJECT: **CORONAVIRUS 2019 (COVID-19) UPDATED GUIDANCE FOR CHILD CARE SETTINGS**

**Provider Information Notice (PIN) Summary**

PIN 20-15-CCP provides current Coronavirus (COVID-19) guidance from the Governor's Office for all child care settings and providers. This PIN and the updated statewide COVID-19 guidance supersedes [PIN 20-06-CCP](#) that expired June 30, and [PIN 20-04-CCP](#), as it pertains to the staff to child ratio requirements.

The Governor's Office released statewide COVID-19 guidance for providers to create a safe and low-risk environment as California businesses begin to open. The California Department of Public Health, Department of Social Services, and Cal-OSHA collaborated to create this guidance. The COVID-19 Updated Guidance: Child Care Programs and Providers is available online at: <https://covid19.ca.gov/pdf/guidance-childcare.pdf>. This guidance supersedes previous COVID-related guidelines in [PIN 20-06-CCP](#) and [PIN 20-04-CCP](#) as it pertains to the staff to child ratio requirements.

Effective immediately, all state-wide waivers modifying staff-to-child ratios are terminated and Child Care Providers must follow requirements pursuant to Title 22, Cal. Code of Regulations, Division 12, sections [101216.3](#), [101216.4](#), [101416.5](#), [101516.5](#), [101616.5](#) and [102416.5](#). Child Care Providers who would like to operate with alternative ratios may submit waiver requests to your Regional Office, which will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
