<b>Group 1</b>	San Mateo County will be reengaging individuals with 48-36 months left on aid	10/2013-12/2013
<b>Group 2</b>	We will then reengage individuals with 35-23 months or less left on aid	1/2014-3/2014
<b>Group 3</b>	Following with individuals with 22-10 months or less left on aid	4/2014-7/2014
<b>Group 4</b>	Lastly, we will then reengage individuals with 9 months or less left on aid	8/20/14-11/2014

Other: San Mateo County plans on providing six Reengagement Evaluation Orientations per month specifically for the AB X 4 4 population. San Mateo County's orientations will provide the AB X 4 4 population with detailed information on the new changes that occurred since the individual became exempt and will follow the recommendations and information provided in ACL 13-01. REO's will be prioritized by each individual's CalWORKs 48-Month Time Clock starting with Group 1 and ending with Group 4. The target is to meet with 27 or more families per month.
