This letter informs counties of an augmentation to the Fiscal Year (FY) 2014-15 Work Incentive Nutritional Supplement (WINS) program allocation.

In consultation with the County Welfare Directors Association, an augment of \$561,000 General Fund was distributed to counties based on a percent to statewide total of the FY 2014-15 WINS appropriation allocation. The amounts displayed on the attachment reflect each counties' revised WINS allocation based on the 2015-16 Governor's Budget.
