This letter informs counties of an augmentation for the FY 2014-15 Promoting Safe and Stable Families (PSSF) Caseworker Visits Grant (CVG) allocation.

In consultation with the County Welfare Directors Association, an augment of \$8,265 in federal funds was distributed to counties based on a weighted calculation of hours per visit, cost per hour and caseload. The amounts displayed on the attachment reflect each county's revised PSSF CVG allocation based on the 2015-16 Governor's Budget.
