SUBJECT: FISCAL YEAR 2015-16 CONTINUUM OF CARE REFORM FOSTER FAMILY  
AGENCY SOCIAL WORK RATE INCREASE GENERAL FUND ALLOCATION

This letter informs counties of the Fiscal Year (FY) 2015-16 allocation for the Continuum of Care Reform (CCR) Foster Family Agency (FFA) social work rate increase. A total of \$7.2 million General Fund (GF) is available as outlined in the Budget Act of 2015, as shown in the Attachment.

Implemented on July 1, 2015, as outlined in [All County Letter No. 15-58E](#), the social work component of the FFA rate received a 15 percent increase. The social work component of \$296 was increased by \$44.40 to \$340.40 for FY 2015-16.

The current claiming process will not change. The 15 percent social work rate increase is reflected on the CA800 FC1, Foster Care Facility Report. In consultation with the County Welfare Directors Association, the distribution of allocation was based on the total FFA expenditures. The payment for the 15 percent increase to the social work component of the FFA rate will be displayed on the Statement of Cash Advance Report – AA190.
