COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENT (COLA)

REFERENCE: ACIN 1-80-06, ACIN 1-72-07, ACIN 1-95-08, I-91-09

The Social Security Administration has announced that recipients will not be receiving a cost-of-living increase in their Social Security benefits. With consumer prices down over the past year, monthly Social Security and Supplemental Security Income benefits for more than 57 million Americans will not automatically increase in 2011. This will be the second year without an automatic COLA since they went into effect in 1975.
