TO: All County Welfare Directors

SUBJECT: FOOD STAMP OUTREACH PROGRAM - F.Y. 1979/80

REFERENCE:

This is to provide information on the status of the Food Stamp Outreach (FSO) program in California.

Effective July 1, 1979, the State Department of Social Services (DSS) entered into contractual agreement with nine community agencies to provide FSO services. The contract period shall be from July 1, 1979 through June 30, 1980. A list of the agencies and their respective regions is attached.

The criteria used in selecting the nine agencies are:

1. Total population of area;
2. Estimated potentially eligible Food Stamp population;
3. To meet federal requirements by providing statewide coverage (northern, southern, coastal, interior, and valley);
4. Availability and accessibility of other community agencies necessary to provide volunteer support; and
5. Target group population to be served (minorities, seniors, Native Americans, migrants) as established by federal regulations.


In addition to the nine contracted agencies, DSS will contract with community agencies in seven other regions. The contracts in these regions will be in effect from October 1, 1979 through June 30, 1980. (A list of the new regions is attached).

ALL-COUNTY INFORMATION NOTICE

For those counties that will not be covered by a contracted agency there will be direct State administration of the program. A representative of the State FSO office will be contacting these counties to provide more detailed information on the direction the program will take in their areas.
