SUBJECT: PROPOSITION 187

On November 22, 1994, federal district court Judge Matthew Byrne issued Temporary Restraining Order in the case of League of United Latin American Citizens v. Wilson concerning the provisions of Proposition 187. The order prohibits the enforcement or implementation in any way of the provisions of Proposition 187 other than Section 2 and 3 relating to the crimes of manufacture, distribution, sale, or use of false citizenship or immigration papers. The Department of Social Services is a defendant in the case.

Paragraph 3 of the order requires the Department to transmit to all county welfare departments a verbatim copy of the temporary restraining order. The order is attached.

Until further order of the court and instructions from this Department, you are to take no action to enforce or implement the provisions of proposition 187. All current regulations, policies and procedures of this Department are to continue to be applied. A hearing has been scheduled for December 14, 1994 in federal district court on plaintiffs' request for issuance of a preliminary injunction. We will keep you informed of developments in the case as they occur.
