SUBJECT: DELETION OF THE CA 800 FED-VOLUNTARY FOSTER CARE (FC)  
FORM

This letter provides information concerning the deletion of the CA 800 (Fed-Voluntary FC), Summary report of Assistance Expenditures Federal Children in Voluntary Foster Care form.

The Federal Department of Health and Human Services Administration for Children and Families announced that they are no longer requiring states to separately report voluntary foster care expenditures on the federal reporting forms. Therefore, the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) has deleted the CA 800 (Fed-Voluntary FC) form.

Effective with the October 2000 claiming month, counties are instructed to stop using the CA 800(Fed-Voluntary FC) form and Aid Code 4C. Instead counties will report their federal Voluntary FC population as Aid Code 42 and report all federal FC expenditures on the CA 800 FC (FED) form. CDSS will reserve Aid Code 4C for future use.

CDSS will review the County Expense Claim (CEC) for Voluntary FC codes to determine if any changes are necessary. Any related changes will be reflected in the March 2001 CEC quarterly timestudy/claiming instruction letter.
