The Commission on Teacher Credentialing's Early Childhood Education (ECE) team is seeking input through a field survey from current preschool teachers, administrators, family childcare owners, county offices, institutional program partners, and other ECE organizations regarding the Child Development Permit.

The Child Development Permit Matrix, originally established in 1993, has only seen one update in 2002 with the addition of the School Age Emphasis. A group of 28 members has worked on formulating recommendations to the Commission, aligned with the California Master Plan for Early Learning and Care (MPELC), to ensure that:

- Early childhood educators are well-prepared for their roles.
- They possess the necessary knowledge and skills to meet the developmental needs of children.
- Employers have access to a well-qualified workforce.
- Quality monitoring is integrated into the preparation of the ECE workforce.
- Competencies (ECE TPEs) are aligned with the MPELC and the proposed new structure for the Child Development Permit.

The feedback collected from this survey will help shape future recommendations to the Commission. Your insights are a crucial part of this process. El equipo de educación en la niñez temprana (ECE) de la Comisión de Credenciales de Maestros está solicitando comentarios a través de una encuesta de campo de maestros de preescolar, administradores, propietarios de cuidado infantil en casa de familia, oficinas del condado, socios de programas institucionales y otras organizaciones de ECE sobre el permiso de desarrollo infantil actuales.

La matriz de permisos de desarrollo infantil, establecida inicialmente en 1993, solo fue actualizada una vez en 2002 con el agregado del énfasis en la edad escolar. Un grupo de 28 miembros ha trabajado para formular las recomendaciones a la Comisión, en alineación con el plan maestro de California para el aprendizaje y el cuidado tempranos (MPELC) para asegurarse de que:

- Los educadores de la niñez temprana estén bien preparados para sus roles.
- Posean el conocimiento y las destrezas necesarios para satisfacer las necesidades de desarrollo de los niños.
- Los empleados tengan acceso a una fuerza de trabajo bien capacitada.
- El control de calidad se integre en la preparación de la fuerza de trabajo de la ECE.
- Las destrezas (expectativas de desempeño en la enseñanza en la ECE) estén alineadas con el MPELC y la estructura propuesta nueva para el permiso de desarrollo infantil.

Los comentarios recopilados en esta encuesta ayudarán a dar forma a recomendaciones futuras a la Comisión. Sus conocimientos son una parte crucial de este proceso.
